

2010 CFC SUMMER SCHOOL

On behalf of the CFC Summer School Staff, we would like to extend a warm welcome to all our past and new participants in our summer program. We are, currently, preparing for another 5 weeks of learning, adventure, and worship. The positive response of the community for summer school encourages us to embark on another year of academic progress and summer fellowship.

Listed below is a quick overview of the registration process, program, curriculum, and activities for the summer. We hope that this brief description will give you a picture of the summer program and answer any general questions you may have.

REGISTRATION

Enclosed, you will find an application form that ***must be filled out for each child*** you wish to enroll in the program. This year, we will be conducting a few on-site registration nights to expedite the enrollment process. If you wish to enroll your child in summer school, please bring your registration forms and payment to Community United Church of Christ (CUCC) located at 805 S. Sixth Street in Champaign, IL at the following open registration times:

- Tuesday, April 13th: 6-9 PM
- Saturday, April 17th: 2-5 PM
- Wednesday, April 21st: 7-10 PM
- Saturday, April 24th: 3-6 PM

We will not be accepting applications by mail before this time. All applications will be accepted and processed on the above registration days. If you cannot attend the above days, applications will be accepted by mail only on a rolling basis. Details for mail-in registration will be available after May 1st on the CFC website (www.cfchome.org/summerschool).

All kindergarten registrants will be required to show proof of birth. Please bring a copy of a birth certificate or any other form of identification that can validate birth date.

CURRICULUM

- The teachers will be using an inquiry-based approach to teaching, which will include hands-on exploration, simulations, investigations, and projects as products.
- Reading, writing, math, science, history, and the arts will be integrated into a larger thematic study.
- The placement of each of the students in their classes will be determined by grade level.

ACTIVITIES

- Afternoons will consist of a variety of activities from swimming, group games, bowling, outdoor activities, and elective courses.
- Students should bring a pair of gym or athletic shoes and swim wear each day so that they may fully participate in the afternoon activities.
